

Abstract Submission

The congress will be based on invited lectures, oral and poster presentations.

The IDMC 2011 welcomes very much the abstract submission from anyone of those who are interested in dental materials, biomaterials and the related technologies. The official language of the meeting will be English. Details in the abstract submission procedures and the abstract template are posted on the meeting website (<http://www.idmc2011.com>).

Notes:

1. Deadline for submission of abstracts is **January 31, 2011**.
2. Save your abstract with Microsoft Word 2003/ Windows.
3. Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion and Conclusion must be included in the abstract.
4. The abstract should be made with one page with A4 size (210 x 297 mm). The margins of top, bottom, left, and right should be 25 mm.
5. All abstracts must be submitted via the congress website only. After clicking the [Abstract Submission] button on the website, fill out the presenter's information form and attach your abstract file. After successful completion of the abstract submission, you may check your abstract thereafter if you log in the homepage with your registered ID.
6. The acceptance of abstract will be notified to the presenter by February 28, 2011.
7. All submitters of accepted abstracts are expected to register for and attend the meeting. Abstracts without registration and payment by April 15, 2011 will not be embodied in the PROCEEDINGS.
8. The winners of Young Investigator Awards will be selected by the committee among those who applied for the competition and make a presentation at the IDMC2011 Young Investigator Award session.
9. If an emergency arises and the presenter is unable to attend, he/she must notify

in writing prior to the meeting that he/she is withdrawing the abstract or naming a substitute presenter.
10. Individual poster should fit within 115 cm wide × 190 cm high poster board (poster size of 100 cm wide × 120 cm high is recommended).

Guidelines for Presentation

1. Abstracts should be based on previously unpublished data.
2. Oral and poster presentation might be in English.
3. The program committee will review all the abstracts and decide on the presentation type (Oral or Poster) based on the author's application and program requirements. Abstract acceptance, program scheduling and the form of presentation will be communicated via email only to the primary author of abstract.

Content of abstract

Research articles - Introduction, objectives, materials and methods, results and conclusion, reference and acknowledgements are optional.

Case reports - Introduction, objectives, case operation procedures and conclusion (underlined)

Please use the attached sample of the abstract. Write according to the sample. Use Times New Roman and single line spacing throughout the abstract. Title should avoid unusual abbreviations. Type the title (14 point bold,), authors' names, affiliations and addresses (12 point bold) as the sample.

Style: Use separate sections for introduction, materials and methods, results, discussion, conclusions, acknowledgements (when appropriate), and references (when appropriate). Type the section headings in bold style without indentation.

Body Text: Use Times New Roman typeface (12 point regular) throughout. Start a new paragraph by indenting it from the left margin.

Please underline the important part of your purpose of the study in Introduction and the important information of your results in Result and/or Discussion.

Tables and Figures: Paste tables and figures where needed, and provide a caption for each table and figure. Place captions above the tables and beneath the figures. The illustrations or graphics will be printed in black and white only. If there is a color illustration it will appear in color, only in PC document. Photographs could be pasted in the text, and the quality of the photograph should be high enough to be reproduced. However, due to limitation of the server, the total size of the abstract file should be less than 2 MB per each abstract.

Number references in their text citation order by an Arabic number. List these in numerical order at the end of abstract under the heading 'References'.
